We are pleased to announce with this new issue of the Bulletin de la Dialysis à Domicile (BDD), the bilingual journal of the RDPLF, the recent signing of a partnership agreement between the International Society of Peritoneal Dialysis (ISPD) and the RDPLF. The RDPLF now officially ensures the French translation of international open access recommendations published by the ISPD.

The goal is to allow better distribution to French-speaking professionals who have difficulty accessing English-language medical literature.

We had been already doing these translations for many years, but we had to get an agreement each time. From now on, it will be automatic within the framework of this partnership, respecting the copyright rules which are recalled on the first page of each translation.

In addition, as part of this partnership, a webinar in French will be organized on an annual basis, in collaboration with the ISPD which will ensure logistics management. The dates will be communicated later.
